Behind every performance there is a remarkable team of artists, leaders, and staff with a shared passion to bring the best of ballet to the stage.

Company Artists

Cleveland Ballet is home to 28 resident company artists that have made Cleveland their home. Representing 10 different countries, dancers come from as far as Japan and Russia, or as near as here in Cleveland. They contribute to the vibrant cultural fabric of our region and bring exceptional artistry to the stage.

Board of Directors

Our 18 Board Members reflect leadership from corporate, professional services, and non-profit sectors throughout Northeast Ohio's communities. Representing Cuyahoga, Summit, and Portage counties, they provide vital governance and guidance.

Trainees

Seven talented trainees devote themselves full-time to the demanding work of perfecting their technique and artistry as they prepare for a professional career, working and performing alongside the company.

Staff

A small but mighty team of 15 staff members work tirelessly to make productions possible. From production planning and operations to patron services and fundraising, this dedicated group brings each season to life and moves the company forward.

Academy of Cleveland Ballet

More than 85 budding ballet dancers - young and old alike attend weekly training from faculty comprised of current and former professional dancers from Cleveland Ballet. Special scholarships are provided for students and company trainees to fulfill dreams for young dancers who otherwise may not have the resources to train with professional dancers.



Cleveland Ballet transports audiences and creates memorable experiences

Cleveland Ballet is rooted in its mission to ensure that world-class ballet is accessible and relevant to audiences of all ages and backgrounds. As such, Cleveland Ballet creates dance and community impact programs of the highest levels of excellence.

Main Stage

As a proud resident company of Playhouse Square, Cleveland Ballet's Main Stage season included three productions - each with a sold-out performance for a total of 19 presentations in the heart of downtown Cleveland.

ChoreoLab

Created and managed by the dancers of Cleveland Ballet,

ChoreoLab features choreography by and for the artists with all proceeds benefiting them. Attendance at the 2025 *ChoreoLab* more than doubled with standingroom-only attendance at the Patrons Circle after party where all ticket holders were invited.

Northeast Ohio

During the 2024-2025 season, Cleveland Ballet performed 35 times throughout Northeast Ohio. In addition to its Main Stage programs, Cleveland Ballet performed with a number of arts organizations, and as part of Playhouse Square productions.

Patron Experience

Cleveland Ballet delivers on its promise to transport audiences through memorable moments on stage and off. Patrons enjoy photo opps with dancers, face jewels for children, artist talks, and after parties.

Record Attendance

The 2024-2025 season marked the highest attendance figures in Cleveland Ballet's 10-year

history. A total of 26,566 patrons attended Playhouse Square's Main Stage program, exceeding last season by 2,500 tickets which also was a recordbreaking year. When you add community engagements and impact programming in the community, Cleveland Ballet performed to more than 35,000 patrons throughout Northeast Ohio.

By making ballet accessible, we can create a more vibrant and diverse dance community, expand opportunities for individuals, and encourage a more authentic reflection of the world.

Pay What You Can

Cleveland Ballet is delivering on its core values of inclusivity and accessibility through its *Pay What You Can* program.

World-class ballet should be barrier-free, especially for children and seniors who may not have the resources or ability to attend a performance. Nearly 4,000 patrons - area schools representing all grades, home schoolers, and older adults attended the reduced-price performances at Playhouse Square.

Behind the Curtain

Patron surveys repeatedly show that artist talks are the best way to enhance ballet

experiences. So Cleveland Ballet launched what is quickly becoming a popular offering, Behind the Curtain, with free preperformance insights from the artistic staff.

The UH Drusinsky Sports Medicine Institute and Cleveland Ballet have forged a partnership to ensure the ballet athletes receive comprehensive sports medicine care from the same medical team as Cleveland Browns and other athletes.

The American Red Cross and **Cleveland Ballet partnered for a** special blood drive in Playhouse Square as part of the ballet's presentation of Dracula. The blood drive's goal was exceeded by 5 pints, which helped replenish the shelves after the devastation and loss of blood collection caused by Hurricane Helene.

Commitment to Youth

Cleveland Ballet has a longstanding partnership with Boys & Girls Clubs to introduce students to ballet to cultivate an appreciation of the art. Students from Boys and Girls Clubs throughout Northeastern Ohio experience exclusive behind the scenes rehearsals at the ballet's studios prior to attending the productions at Playhouse Square. Each year hundreds of Girl Scouts attend performances and earn special "Arts & Culture" badges.
